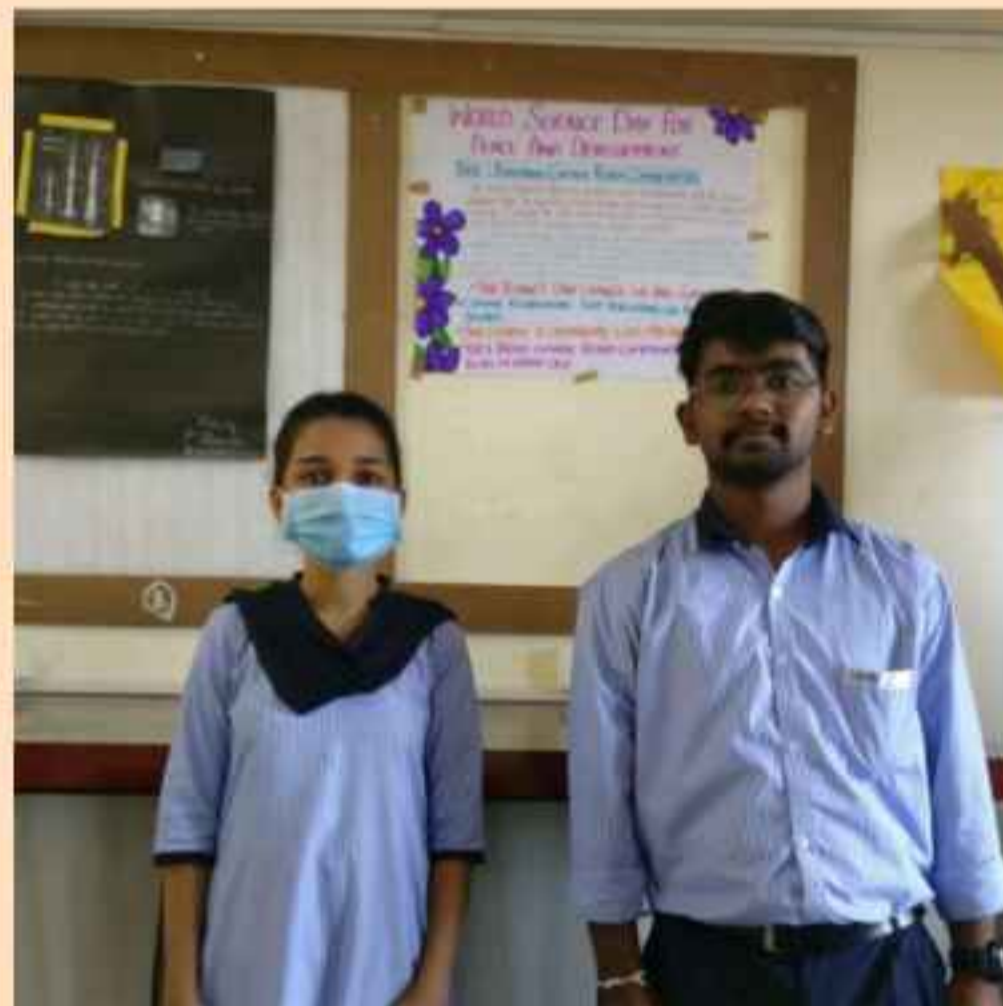
## National Pollution Control Day

### *3-Day Webinar Report*

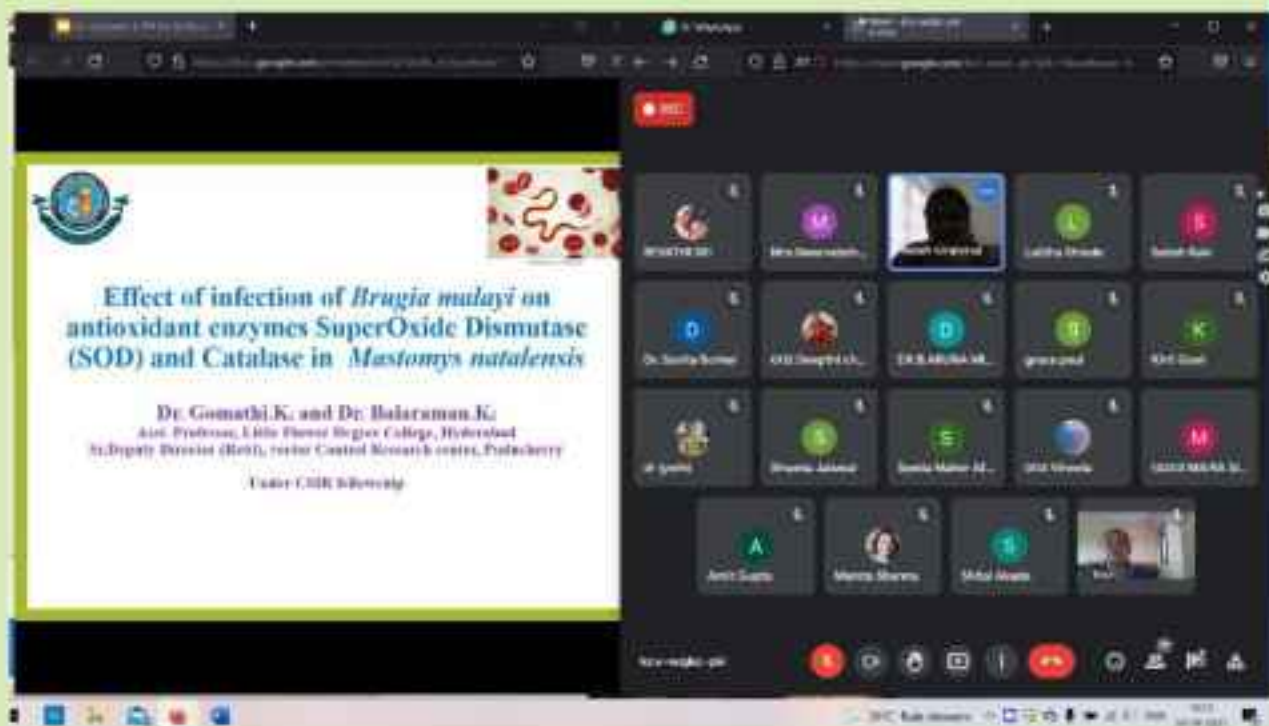

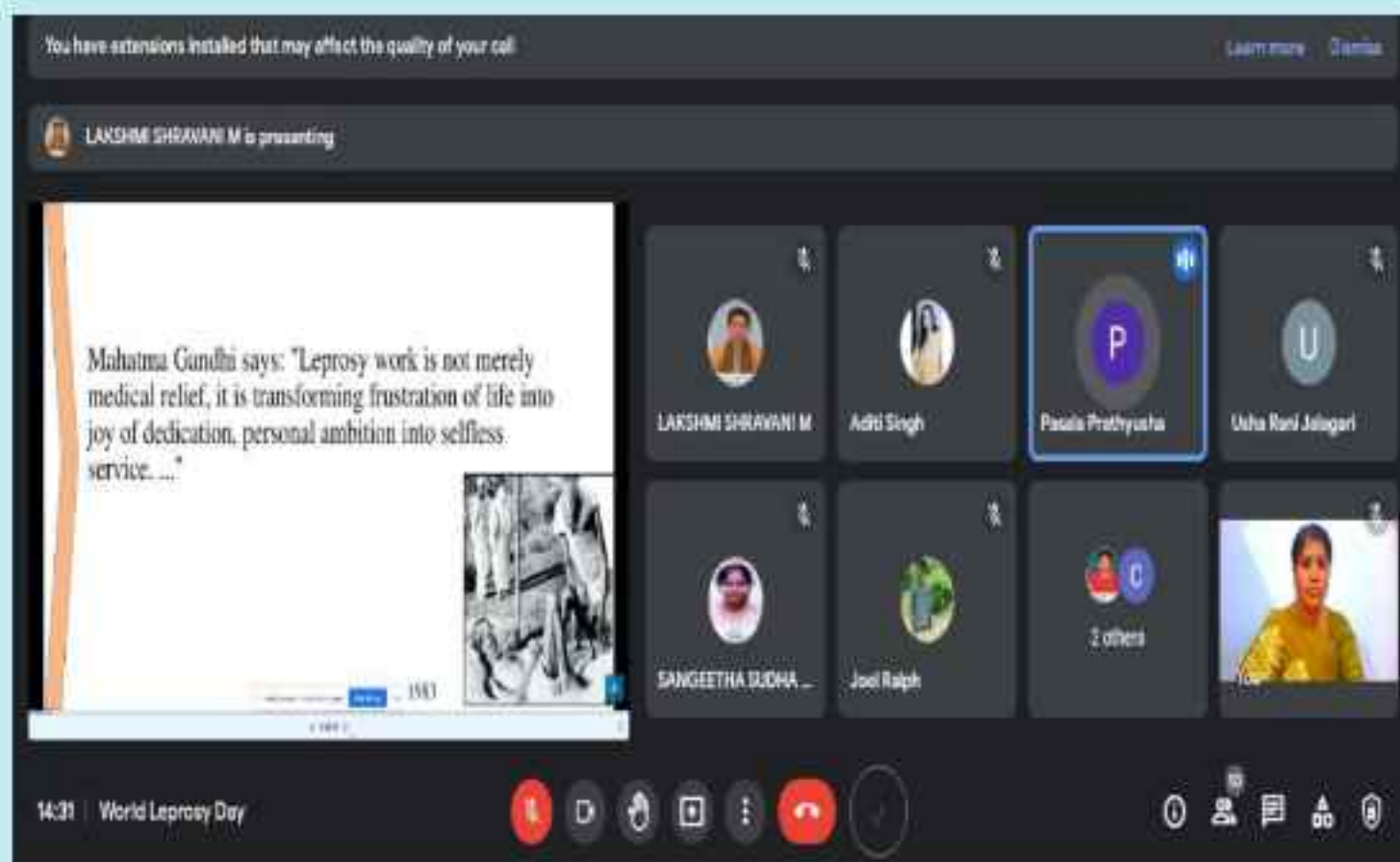
## National Level IP Literacy Awareness Programme on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

The Department of English organised an online webinar on the topic "Importance of English for Competitive/Entrance Exams" (CAT/IELTS/BANK/ICET) on 4th February, 2022. The speaker Mr. J. Raghevender spoke about the importance of the English language in competitive exams. Students preparing for competitive exams must have English skills. About 20 to 30% of marks are allotted for the English Section in each competitive exam and entrance exam. Competitive exams are like UGC NET, SSC CGL, IBPS PO etc. and entrance exams are like CAT, MAT, CLAT, CET, etc. One-fourth of the total weightage on the written exam of first level is given to English. After that, Group Discussion and Interview level combined together make 80% score for English language.

He spoke about the two types of tests, generic and specific. Generic test is about the aptitude test where an assessment is used to determine a candidate's cognitive ability or personality and the specific test depends on what kind of job you want to be into.

He spoke about personality development and how you take part in the activities in the college or organise the events that give growth to our personality and make us a confident person. He spoke about how important is English in competitive exams, he stated that Math's needs Intelligence, Physics necessitates Imagination, Chemistry necessitates Agility, Biology necessitates Memory, and GK & Current Affairs necessitate Awareness. Unfortunately, there is no word that we can attach with English to describe "what English requires," because mastering the English language necessitates a combination of variables.

He said that to be perfect with the English language you should have the five language skills : Reading, Listening, Speaking, Writing and Grammar. Even he told that if we mastery over this five skills we can overcome any type of competitive exams and in the last he told to practice, practice and practice

Many plant-based foods are good sources of antioxidants and the dietary antioxidants are molecules in food that help remove free radicals from the body. They focused on the anti-inflammatory diet and spoke about the comparatively harmful aspects of medicines.

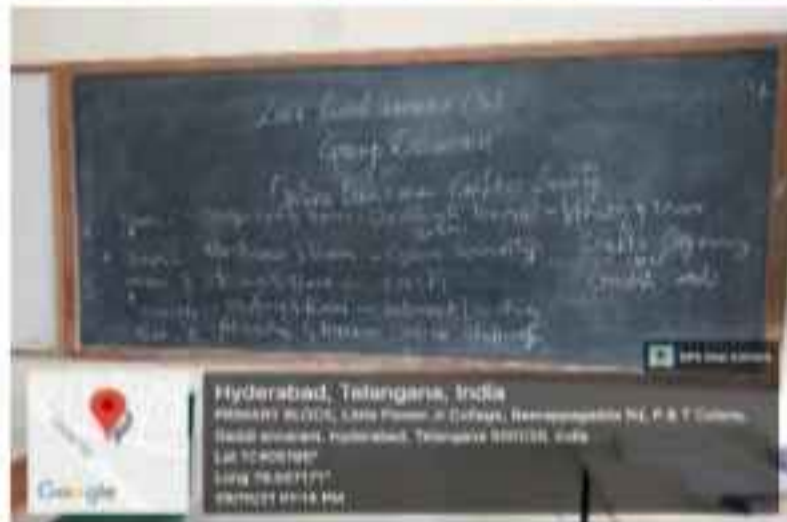


## Photography

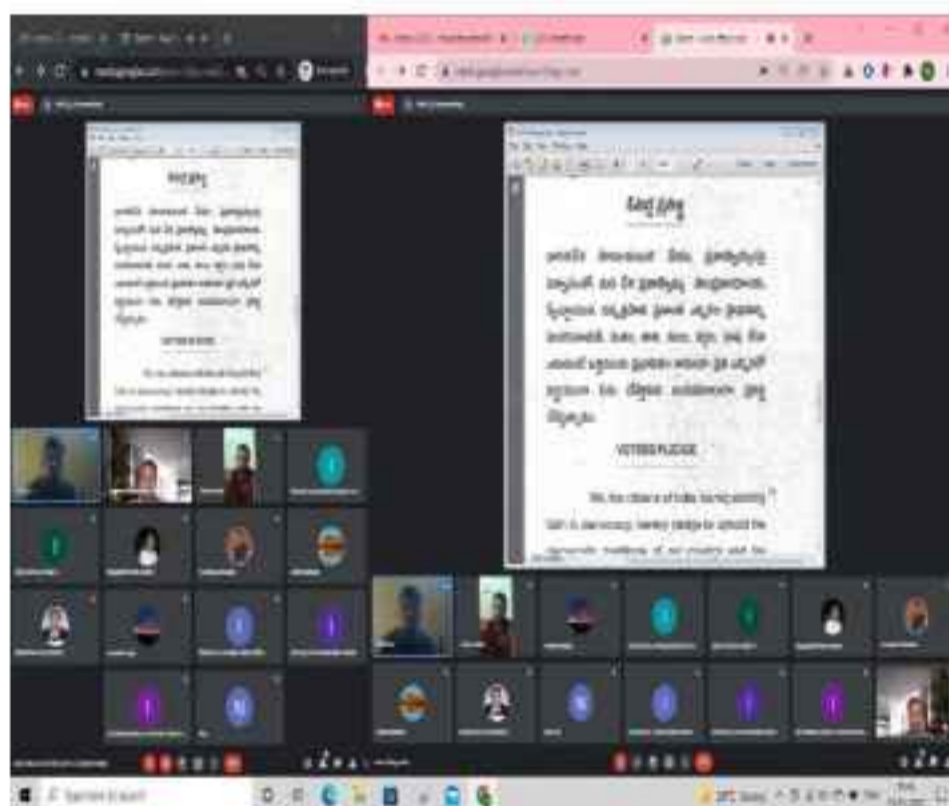


## 12th National Voter's Day Celebrations Report

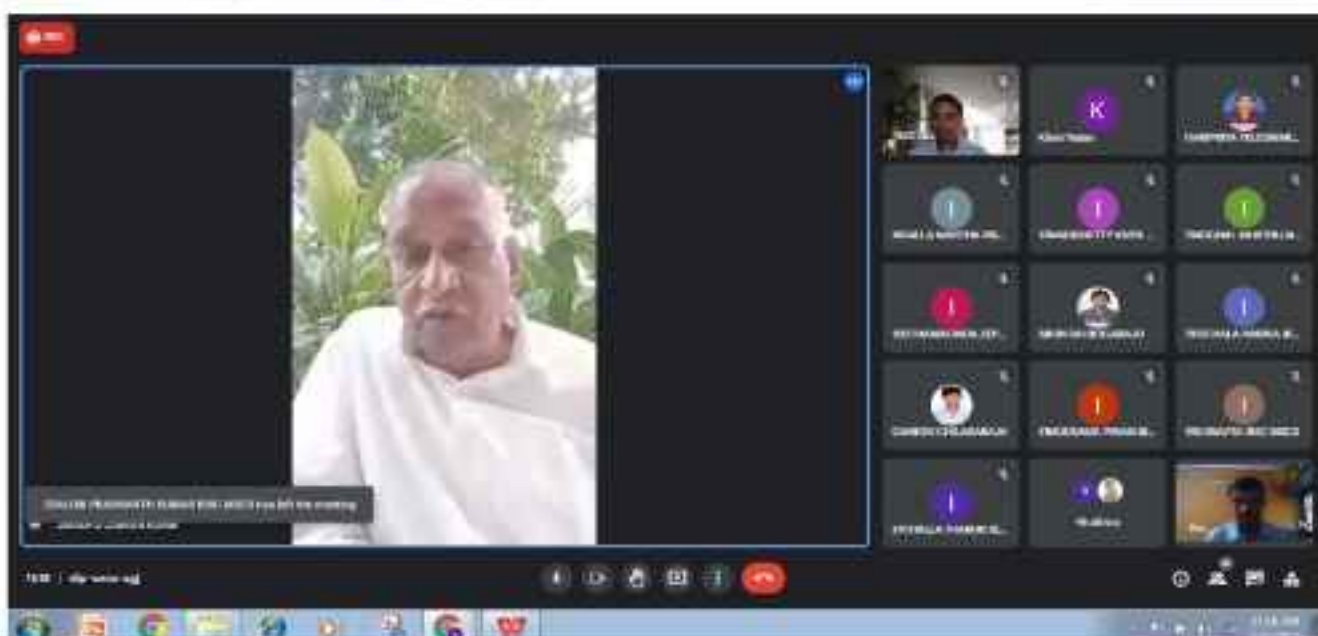

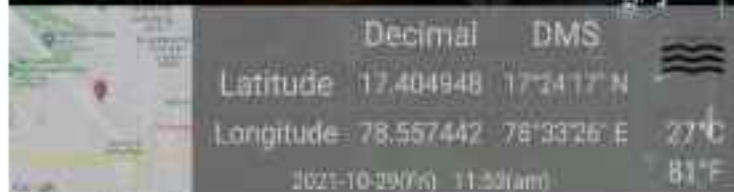


## Food And Waste Management
