

Preface

In its pursuit of academic excellence, quality education and holistic development, LFDC has set up various cells and committees to serve the needs of the students in both curricular and co-curricular activities and provide an opportunity to the faculty to enhance their multifarious skills.

The college constitutes Cells/Committees to streamline the college administration for implementing supportive action programs directed towards achieving the vision and mission of the college. The prime objective of cells/committees is to ensure quality and efficiency. They function as an advisory, recommendatory, monitoring and executing body.

POLICIES

1. Cells/committees have a coordinator and faculty members. A student secretary is selected as per the function and requirement of the cells/committees. The tenure of members is of **three years** and additions/ changes are made to the group as per requirements.

2. Details of constituted Cells/Committees are published in the college handbook every academic year and updated on the college website for easy access to students and stakeholders.

3. Cells/Committees deal with long-term/ongoing programs and propose actions in the functional areas under their influence, subject to final approval by the Principal/Vice principal.

4. Meetings of the Cells/Committees are held as per the requirements of the functions. Student secretaries are to be present when required.

5. The Cells/Committees coordinator's responsibility includes scheduling meetings, preparing agendas, and documentation for the efficient management of cells/committees.

6. Treasurer takes responsibility for financial matters and he/she is accountable to the coordinator of cells/committees.

7. Ad Hoc committees are created as per the needs and are dissolved after achieving the objective. (E.g.: Decennial)

CELLS

1. Alumni Relations (LAGAN)

Form a network of former students that will help the institution to play an active role in mentoring the students in their areas of expertise.
