LITERARY POLICY



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Preface

The Literary activities policy sets the framework for fostering a vibrant literary culture on campus. It promotes intellectual excellence and competency to accomplish the vision of the institution. It is committed to enhancing and transforming the overall student Personality that is not possible in just the classroom setting, creating a strong platform for students across the faculty of Arts, Commerce and science to exhibit their talents. Every student is encouraged to participate in these activities whether conducted in the college or with other colleges. The college organizes Intra and Inter competitions, College Fest and 'Festa Letteraria' every year for students to exhibit their intellectual capabilities and create a healthy competition amongst them.

1. Objective

- Encourage students, faculty and staff to actively engage through various activities related to literary engagement.
- Provide a platform for students to explore and express their literary creativity.
- Celebrate and promote diversity by showcasing works from different cultures, languages and perspectives.
- Improve communication skills and interpersonal communication through participation in literary activities.
- Support the educational mission and goals of the college by promoting literacy, critical thinking, creativity and cultural awareness among students.

2. Scope

Encouraging the establishment and support of students let literary clubs and organizations focus on different genres, themes and interests.

Providing opportunities for students to participate in various literary events to develop their skills.

Hosting competitions in literary events to showcase students' talent and creativity.

Facilitating publication of student run magazine to showcase the creativity of college community

Organizing annual literary festivals and events to promote literary engagement among students.

3. Composition

- Principal
- Vice Principal

- Student Secretary
- Academic club coordinator (9 Faculty)
- Student club secretary (9 students)

4. Roles, Responsibilities and Functions

- Planning and executing and coordinating literary events such as intra and intercollegiate events with coordinators from all faculty
- Creating promotional material for literary events posters, flyers, social media posts etc.
- Securing venues, equipment and other resources for literary events
- Recruiting student volunteers to help with organizing literary events as well as encouraging student participation.
- Ensuring diversity and inclusivity in the content chosen for literary activities
- Keeping records of attendance, feedbacks for each literary event.

5. Policy

5.1 The management selects the Literary convenor and approves the club coordinators. A faculty coordinator is selected for the period of three years (there may be an extension/replacement if the situation requires).

5.2 Each year a student secretary is selected from the final year who has actively participated and has won laurels in various literary events in the first and second graduate years, without any arrears.

5.3 The Student coordinator should coordinate with the committee members regarding Literary Events.

5.4 The Literary Committee has the right to take decisions in consultation with management regarding Literary activities.

5.5 The Committee assigns Responsibility to staff and students for organizing/managing any event and it should be taken seriously and performed with utmost sincerity

5.6 The student coordinator can take student volunteers to oversee the activities and inform the same to the literary coordinator and ensure cooperation among the students involved.

5.7 Students participating in programmes organized by other colleges during college hours should obtain permission from the literary coordinator, class in charge and parents.

5.8 For literary competitions each club coordinator decides the events for their respective faculty.

5.9 Literary competitions under any discipline will be organized if the minimum number of participants is ten, else the competition stands cancelled.

5.10 In each competition the judges should evaluate according to the criteria and the judge's decision is final and there is no room to challenge his/her decision.

5.11 Winners are awarded certificates, mementos and cash prizes.

5.12 Best student 'Literary' is awarded to students for participating and winning more awards in intra and inter collegiate Literary competitions conducted at college, university, state level.

6. Literary Activities

Some of the activities conducted are Quiz, Declamation, Elocution, Poster Presentations, Public Speaking, Collage Making, Poetry Recitation, Assembling, Creative Writing, Treasure Hunt, Model Presentations. Cosplays etc.,
