

Faculty Orientation Programme Teacher-student Relationship and Self Awareness

Little Flower Quality Assessment Cell (LFQAC) organized a Faculty Orientation Program on July 12, 2023, to enhance faculty's understanding of fostering positive relationships with students and increasing self-awareness in teaching practices. The resource person, Dr. G. Padmaja, Associate Professor and Head, the Centre for Health Psychology School of Medical Science, University of Hyderabad, explained both topics in two sessions, actively engaging the faculty. Talking about the teacher-student relationship, ma'am explained 'Transactional Analysis, a psychoanalytic theory used for determining the ego state (parent-like, childlike, or adult-like) as a basis for understanding behaviour. And to help improve and develop self-awareness. Dr. Padmaja expounded on the Johari Window Model, which would aid in understanding relationships with ourselves and others. Sessions were lively, interactive, and practical strategies and insights were discussed.
