## The Periodic Labour Force Survey Arude

The Periodic Labour Force Survey provides yearly and quarterly evaluations of key employment and unemployment indicators such as the labour participation rate, employee population ratio, proportion of jobless etc. Among the Indian states, Meghalaya has the lowest unemployment rate, while Haryana has the highest unemployment rate according to the Periodic Labour force survey.

Now the fifth Annual Report is being brought out by NSSO on the
 basis of Periodic Labour Force Survey conducted during July 2021-June 2022.

Data released by the National Statistical Office (NSO) in its annual report Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) offers insights into the process of structural transformation in the Indian economy.
In the Annual Reports of PLFS, estimates of labour market indicators are presented on the basis of the data collected during the period July of a year to June of the next year, e.g., in the Annual Report, PLFS, 2021-22 estimates are presented based on data collected during July 2021 - June 2022.
The samples of First Stage Units (FSU) of Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) canvassed during the period July of one year to June of the next year are independently drawn for each quarter before commencement of the survey. Since the quarterly samples are drawn independently, estimates of labour force indicators for a calendar year have been obtained by combining the data of four quarters of the calendar year. For example, the samples for the four quarters, namely, January - March 2022, April-June 2022, July - September 2022 and October - December 2022 of the calendar year 2022 have been combined to produce the estimates of key labour market indicators for the calendar year 2022. The estimates are derived on the basis of the data collected during first visit of the survey.
The labour force consists of persons who are of age 15 years or older, and belong to either of the following two categories: Employed Unemployed and are willing to work and are actively looking for a job. There is a crucial commonality between the two categories - they both have people "demanding" jobs. This demand is what Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) refers to. While those in category 1 succeed in getting a job, those in category 2 fail to do so. Essentially, LFPR is the number of people ages 15 and older who are employed or actively seeking employment, divided by the total noninstitutionalized, civilian working-age population. LFPR represents the demand for
jobs in an economy. On the other hand, Unemployment Rate (UER), which is routinely quoted in the news, is nothing but the number of unemployed (category 2) as a proportion of the labour force.
Since 2011-12, the structural transformation from agriculture to manufacturing has slowed, with the share of agriculture in employment not falling fast enough and, in fact, rising after 2018-19. The share of manufacturing has dropped behind even that of construction and trade, hotels \& restaurants. In 2021-22, manufacturing's share, at 6\%, was below that of construction ( $12.4 \%$ ) as well as trade, hotels \& restaurants ( $\mathbf{1 2 . 1 \%}$ ). In other words, structural transformation hasn't just slowed - it has stalled, if not reversed. There is not much labour transfer taking place from farms to factories.The jobs that are getting generated outside agriculture are mostly in construction and lowpaid services, whose share has overtaken that of manufacturing. The construction sector has now become the second-largest employer after agriculture. Five years ago, it was at No. 4, after agriculture, manufacturing and trade, hotels \& restaurants. Today, manufacturing has been relegated to the fourth spot.

The Highlights of PLFS are:

1. Unemployment Rate: It shows that the unemployment rate fell to $4.2 \%$ in 2020 21, compared with $4.8 \%$ in 2019-20. The rural areas recorded an unemployment rate of $3.3 \%$ and urban areas recorded an unemployment rate of $6.7 \%$.
2. Force Participation Rate (LFPR): The percentage of persons in the labour force (that is, working or seeking work or available for work) in the population increased from 40.1\% in the previous year to 41.6\% during 2020-21.
3. Worker Population Ratio (WPR): It increased from $38.2 \%$ of the previous year to 39.8\%.
4. Migration Rate: The migration rate is $\mathbf{2 8 . 9 \%}$. The migration rate among women was $48 \%$ and $47.8 \%$ in rural and urban areas, respectively.
5. The farm sector produces less 'output', but 'adds more value' - that is why it is able to support 45\% of the country's employed labour force. But it is necessary for India to have fewer people in agriculture.
6. The NSSO's latest annual Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) report for 2021-22 (July-June) shows the farm sector's share in the country's employed labour force at 45.5\%. That's down from 46.5\% in 2020-21, but still higher than the 2018-19 low of 42.5\%
