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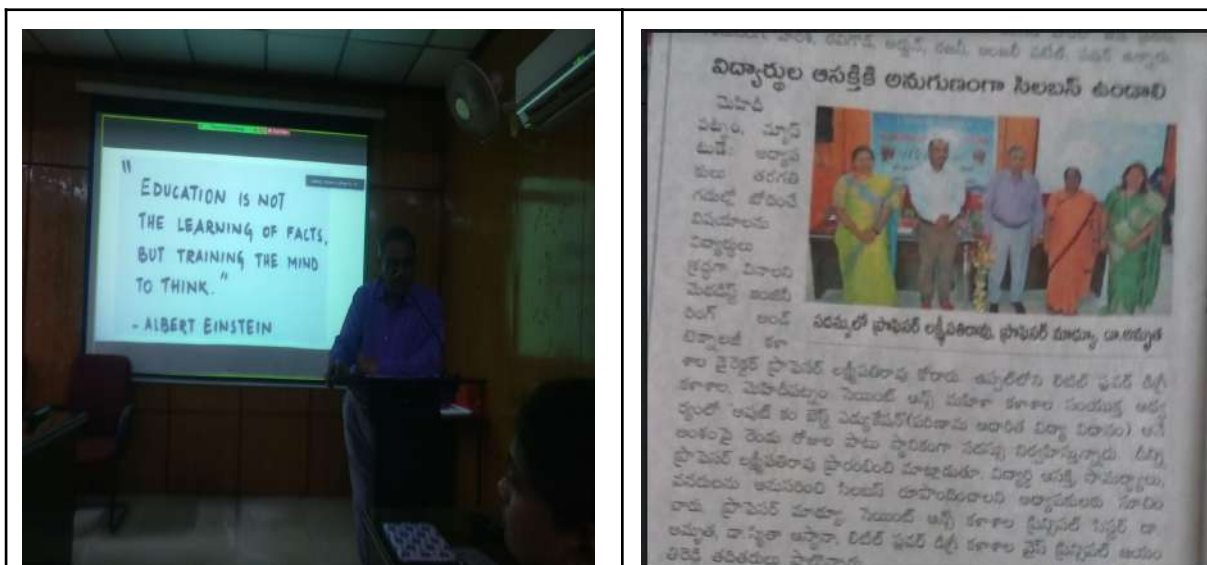
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National Workshop on Outcome Based Education

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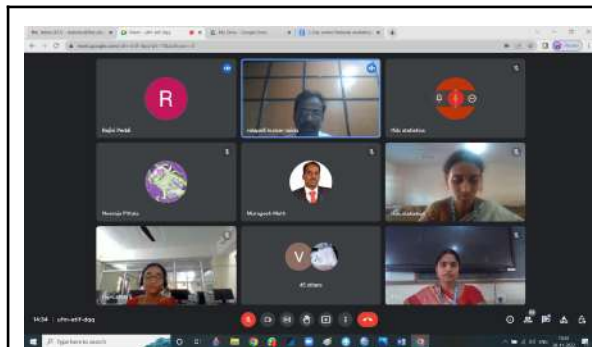
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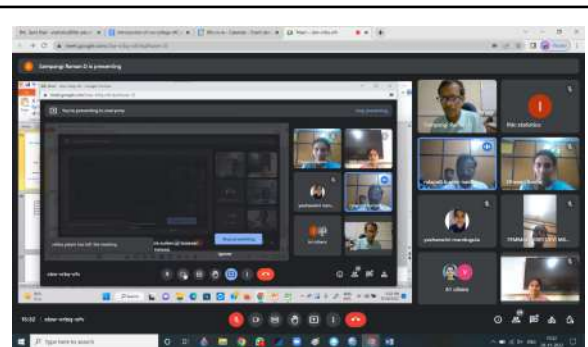
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National Workshop on “Research & Project Development using Statistical Techniques”
