

A national webinar was organized by Department of Modern Language and Political Science via Zoom. The first session was taken up by the department of Political Science, Fr. Dr. Binoy Jacob, Director, Loyola Institute of Peace and International Relation, Kochi, Kerala enlightened the participants on the topic 'Transforming structures towards building peace.' And the second session was taken up by the department of Modern Language. Dr. Archana Murthy, Asst. Prof and HOD, English PG, DBPM Degree and PG College for women, Secunderabad, spoke on the topic 'Literary voices reflecting racism.' She defined racism as prejudice, discrimination or antagonism directed against a person, people or members of a particular racial or ethnic group typically one that is a minority or marginalized. She spoke about postcolonial feminism and said that it is one aspect of third wave feminism. It reflects complex layers of oppression that exist within any given society. Explaining about the Voice of Postcolonial theorists, she mentioned Chandra Talpade Mohanty, a theorist of postcolonial movement, in her essay "Under western eyes" where she asserts that western feminists write about third world women as composite, singular construction that arbitrary and limiting.









Dr. Parimala Kulkarni, explained in detail how gender role differs based on cultures and how gender expectations create differences and trouble. She gave more insight on "stereotype", its definition, and types. Gender Stereotyping is an unconscious bias most of the time and it greatly affects self- perception. Media and Marketing are great examples showing Gender Stereotyping. She gave examples of characters and writers from literature such Elizabeth Bennet, Jane Eyre, Emma Bovary, and Akhila, Robert Browning's My Last Duchess, Elizabeth Barret Browning. Giving these examples she elucidated how gender stereotypes shape self-perception, attitudes to relationships and influence one's involvement in the world around them.







Dr. Sharada explained the status of India before the arrival of the British and the foundation of British Empire was laid by exploration, expansion and exploitation. On the other hand, the speaker also explained about the transformation that was brought into some of the practices in Indian culture such as Sati and child marriages. The spirit of nationalism that empowered and brought many Indians to fight for their own freedom. On the second day, the Speaker elaborated the three main aspects of Orientalism, the first is the image of East created by the west (a binary concept) which is whatever Europeans stood for the oriental stood for its exact opposite. The Second aspect is the power comes from military conquest, which leads to academic discipline. And the Third aspect is the corporate institutions, the westerners established schools, universities, legislature all over the world which put their ideologies forward and gave us the biased information. She explained Eurocentric and Orientalist ways of defining 'The Other' and concepts of hybridity, gender and the subaltern in the formation of colonial and postcolonial identities.











