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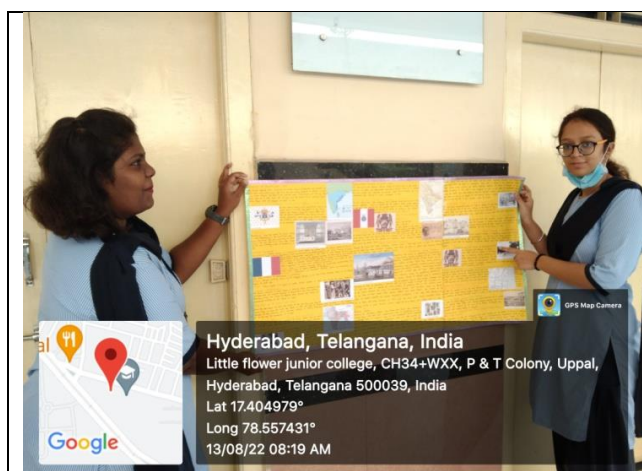

### EUROPEAN COLONIAL POWERS

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### BRITISH RAJ (1858-1947)

British Raj was the rule of British Crown on the Indian subcontinent. It was also called Crown Rule in India, or DIRECT RULE in India. The region under British control, including areas directly administered by UK, was called **BRITISH INDIA**. The area ruled by indigenous rulers but under British suzerainty, called the **PRINCELY STATES**.

It was only after the start of 1858, first experiment with British Government directly administered the subcontinent. To put the end to company rule in India, Queen Victoria was all set of transfer of India and provided that new British government would work for the betterment of the Indian subjects. The position of Governor General of India was replaced by "Viceroy of India". Charles Canning was the first Viceroy of India. To ensure that there would be no change in the rule, British Government came up with **DOING & RULE POLICY**. The Viceroy, Lord Canning laid the philosophy of "Rule of the Ruler" which was the national motto. After Indian people, the motto of British was **DOING & RULE POLICY**. It was to prove and was successful. British Government was the first Viceroy of India. To ensure that there would be no change in the rule, British Government came up with **DOING & RULE POLICY**. 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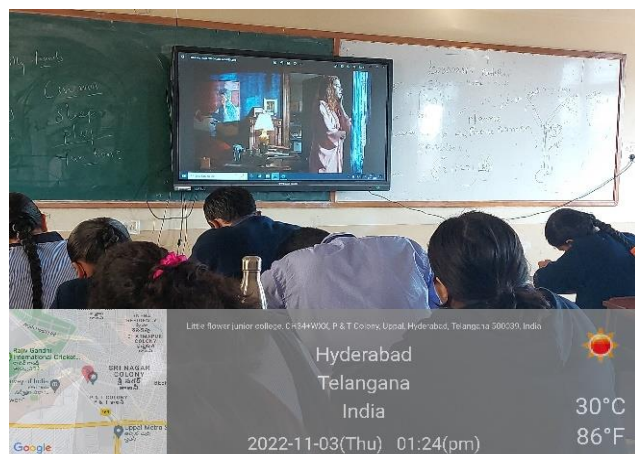
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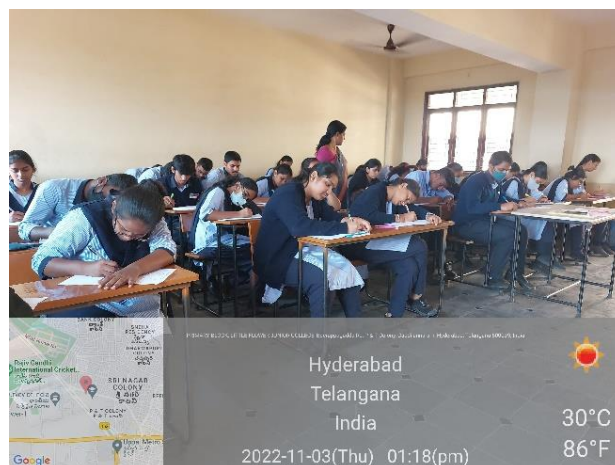
## Creative Writing Competition

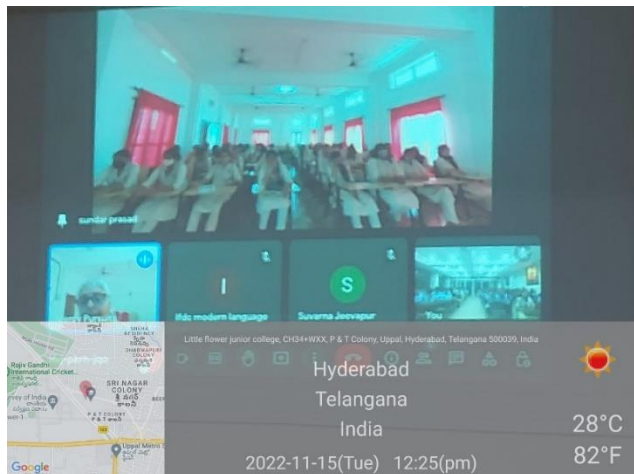

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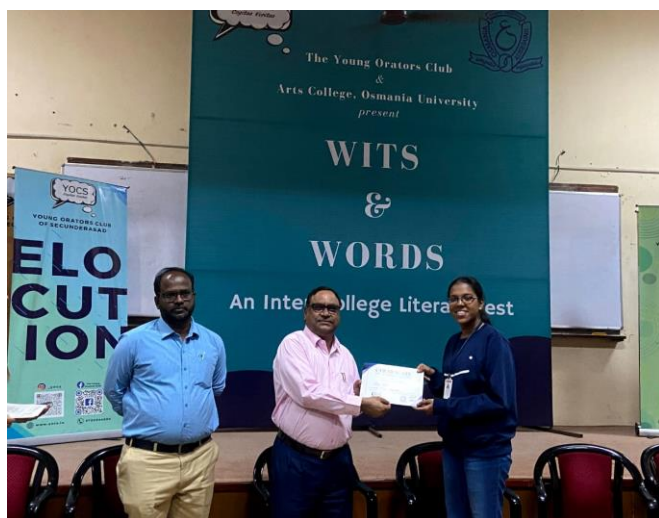

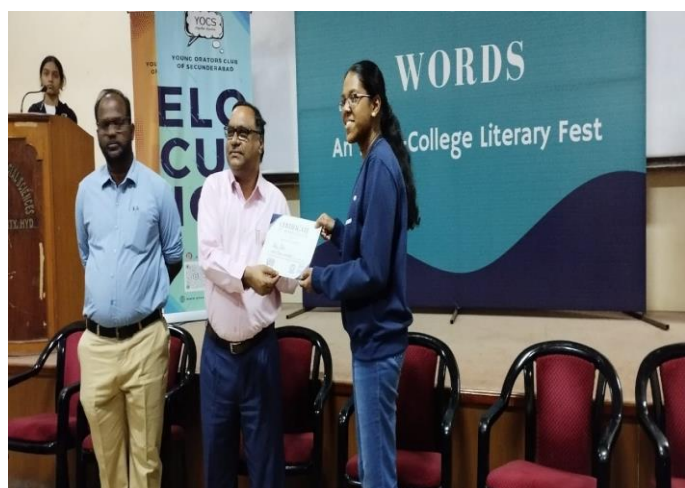

She interacted with students sharing from her own experiences and recommended universities in India and abroad for post-Graduation.

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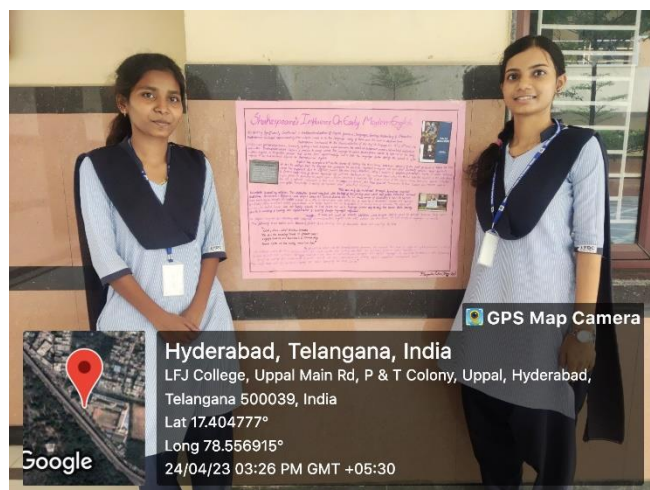
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## CONDUCTED: ENGLISH LANGUAGE WEEK

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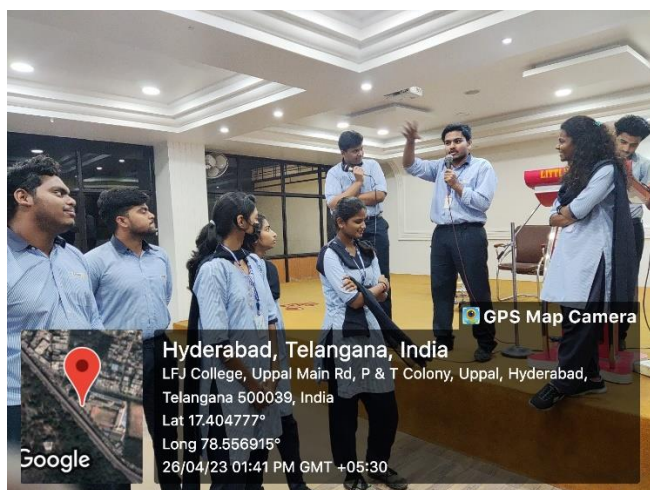
