









The topic for the session was "To think Critically or, not to think Critically: An introduction to research methodology." Varsha explained the basic methodology gave tips on how to write a research paper, importance of a specific topic, citations including facts that are considered as common knowledge. She also specified that Novelists are also researchers as they must research a lot to write in a book. She explained the process of writing a research paper in three parts. The first part is to pick a couple of arguments that have already been made and to summarize those arguments. The second is to put these arguments in context of the topic chosen. The third is to put forward our own arguments. And how important it is to ask fundamental questions to reasons and solutions for these fundamental questions. She interacted with students sharing from her own experiences and recommended universities in India and abroad for post-Graduation.


