Objective: To upskill all the French teachers (teaching at UG level) on the new syllabus - both content and teaching methodologies.

Outcome: The academicians gained several inputs on how to teach French Language at undergraduate level to the students

A Two-day Faculty Development Program was organised by Osmania University in collaboration with Alliance Française of Hyderabad, TSCHE (Telangana State Council of Higher Education), EFLU (The English and Foreign Languages University) and (TSWREIS) Telangana Social Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society on 27th and 28th September 2022 for the French Lecturers who teach the undergraduate students, was attended by Ms. A. Harini, French Faculty, LFDC.

The main objective of the FDP was to equip the undergraduate students of Telangana with the French Language skills needed to clear DELF examinations and seek employment opportunities globally, the TSCHE has decided to introduce a new approach of teaching French by introducing a new textbook Cosmopolite as per the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. This workshop aims to upskill all the French teachers (teaching at UG level) on the new syllabus - both content and teaching methodologies. Resource Persons from Osmania University, English and Foreign Languages University, Alliance Francaise had delivered lectures on different elements of teaching French as Second language.

The lecturers were given copies of the Cosmopolite 1 textbook, workbook and the guide pedagogy to refer and implement the teaching of the book for students of 2022-2023 first year students. The lecturers shared their views about the book and the session. Many dignitaries from OU, TSCHE, TSWREIS and Alliance Francaise had spoken in the valedictory session and certificates were distributed to all the lecturers.

17 National Symbols of India are National Flag - Tiranga, National Anthem - Jana Gana Mana, National Calendar - Saka calendar, National Song - Vande Mataram, National Emblem - National Emblem of India, National Fruit-Mango, National River - Ganga, National Animal - Royal Bengal Tiger, National Tree - Indian Banyan, National Aquatic Animal - Ganges River Dolphin, National Bird - India Peacock, National Currency - Indian Rupee, National Reptile - King Cobra, National Heritage Animal - Indian Elephant, National Flower - Lotus, National Vegetable - Pumpkin, Oath of Allegiance - National Pledge.
