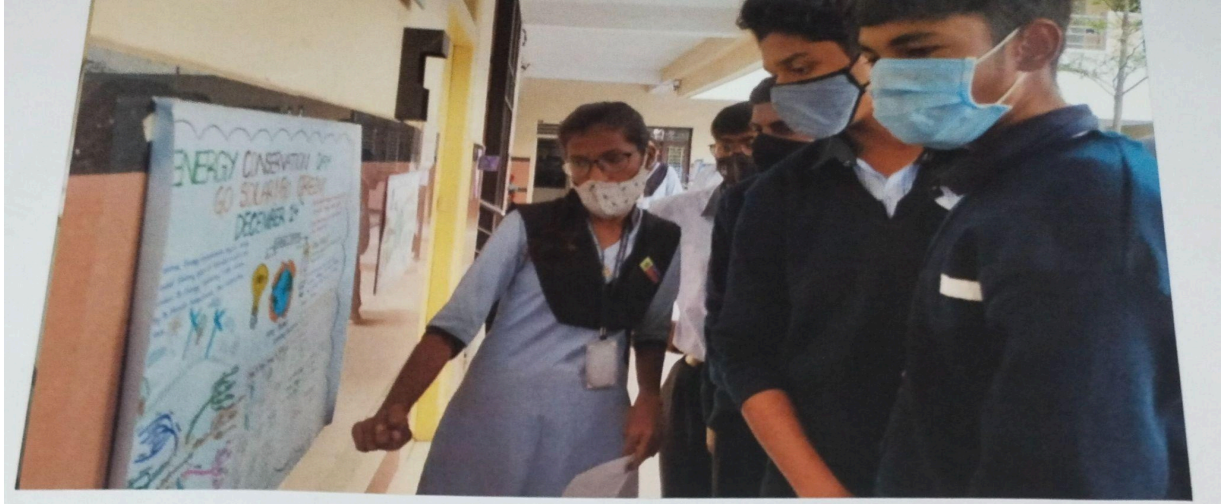

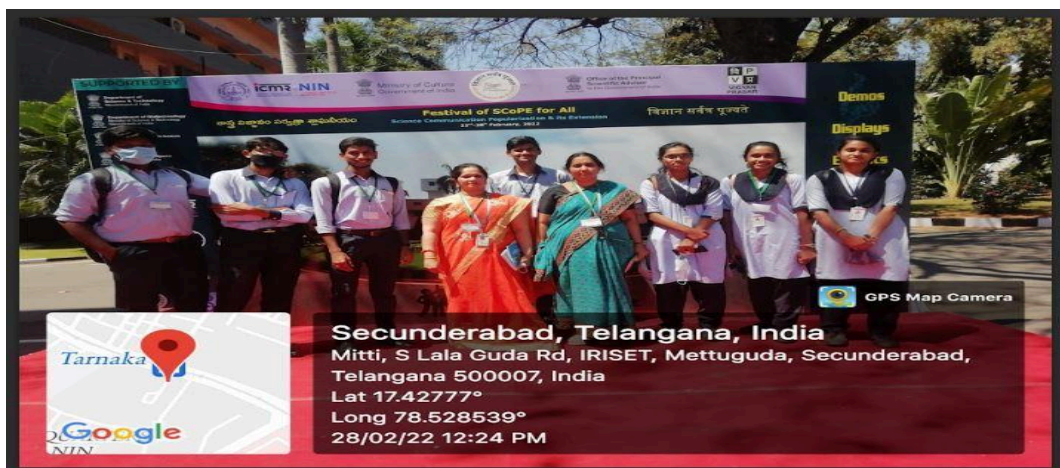

Students of II MPCS along with G.Sreelekh, Head Department of Physics participated in the event and gained knowledge.





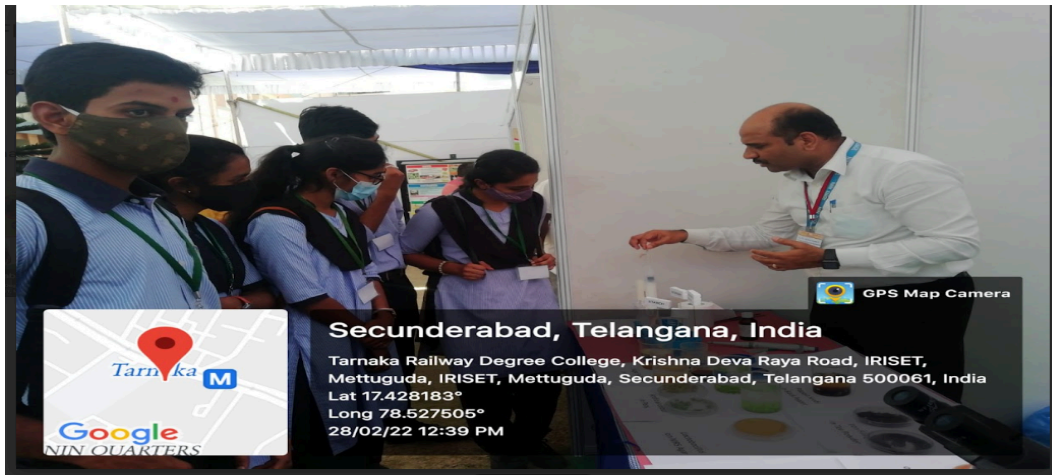
